*The Tasmanian Bus & Coach Society was formed in 2010 in response to a need to establish a body for bus and transport enthusiasts in Tasmania.*

### Objectives

The objectives of the Society are to

- Conduct tours, rallies and public events
- Promote the history of public transport in Tasmania
- Preserve and restore public transport vehicles in Tasmania
- Conduct meetings and events for persons interested in Tasmanian public transport history and vehicles
- Exchange news, views and information related to Tasmanian public transport.

### Tours, Rallies and Events

The Tasmanian Bus and Coach Society has quickly established a reputation for conducting unique and enthralling enthusiast tours, which attract many mainland enthusiasts. Tours are usually held around April but also include mini-tours throughout the year. See our Facebook page for upcoming tours. Members receive discounted rates. Additionally members can take part in regular outings plus the Society participate in many public interest events.

### Preservation and Restoration

The Society have a wide range of unique vehicles. Starting with a Scania N113 VOV1 City-bus donated by Metro in 2010, A rare 1963 AEC Denning coach donated by Dennis Maxwell of Wilmot, the prototype low floor Scania bus 200 was purchased and restored, along with numerous coaches donated by operators, bringing our fleet to 15. All vehicles are operational and displayed at events around the state. Some members also privately own and preserve vehicles.

### Member Meetings

Member outings and an informal meetings are normally held on the last Sunday of the month, as a working bee at our premises in Campbell Town where we also maintain our premises and/or vehicles in readiness for events.
